

# **Canadian Pacific issues adoption notice for DM&E/IC&E lines**

MINNEAPOLIS - In another sign of the integration of the former Dakota, Minnesota & Eastern and Iowa, Chicago & Eastern into its system, Canadian Pacific has sent a notice to its customers that, effective Oct. 11, 2009, it will be adopting all the DM&E/IC&E stations, tariffs, and interchanges. From that date on, all customer routings will use "CPRS" instead of DM&E or IC&E. In 2008 Canadian Pacific acquired the DM&E and IC&E, the nation's largest regional railroad system, but has taken a "go-slow" approach to integration. In January 2009, the IC&E was merged into the DM&E, but the railroad's headquarters remains in Sioux Falls, S.D., and it continues to operate separately from its parent.
